Eligibility

- Previous student participant in a Veterans Heritage Project (VHP) school chapter
- At least 5 years post-graduation from high school
- Contributing to society through public service, the workforce, or volunteering
- Available to attend the award presentation at the *Saluting Stories of Service* gala on March 5, 2022
- Current Staff and Board Directors who are alumni are not eligible

Criteria

- Submissions will be reviewed by the Honor Roll committee and VHP Board of Directors with the score based on:
 - Ability to describe positive impact from veterans, oral history, and/or VHP program activities
 - Demonstration of retained lessons, skills, traits, and/or abilities
 - Continued engagement in civic, community, or leadership activities
- Finalists will be contacted the week of January 10, 2022 with any questions. We may request a 2-minute selfie video describing their most impactful VHP moment
- Notification of selection will be made to all applicants by January 31, 2021
