

Annual Alumni Service Award

Eligibility

- Previous student participant in a Veterans Heritage Project (VHP) school chapter
- At least 5 years post-graduation from high school
- Contributing to society through public service, the workforce, or volunteering
- Available to attend the award presentation at the Saluting Stories of Service gala on March 2, 2024
- Current Staff and Board Directors who are alumni are not eligible

Criteria

- Submissions will be reviewed by the Gala committee and VHP Board of Directors with the score based on:
 - o Ability to describe positive impact from veterans, oral history, and/or VHP program activities
 - O Demonstration of retained lessons, skills, traits, and/or abilities
 - o Continued engagement in civic, community, or leadership activities
- Notification of selection will be made in December

- 4. What lessons did your veteran(s) impart that you still remember? Share example(s) of how those lessons have been applied in your life and/or career.
- 5. How are you contributing to the greater community today?
- 6. Describe any accomplishments or recognition you have received which you attribute in any part to the experiences provided by VHP.
